- This form must be submitted to the IRES Graduate Program Manager and approved by the RES Graduate Advisor **before** starting your Directed Studies course and **before** the term Add/Drop deadline (deadline is usually two weeks after a term begins).
- The RES Directed Studies course code is **RES 500B**.
- Students can register themselves for this course via their UBC SSC accounts after receiving Graduate Advisor approval.
- If your preferred directed studies course instructor is not your supervisor (SV), you must obtain instructor and SV signatures on this form.
 - Note: An IRES Post-Doctoral student or Research Associate may co-instruct an RES Directed Studies course with an IRES faculty member. However, the IRES Faculty member is responsible for the overall running and evaluation of the course.
- The faculty course instructor must confirm via email to the IRES Graduate Program Manager when the student's Directed Studies course is complete and what the student's final percent grade is. The IRES Graduate Program Manager will then enter their RES Directed Studies course mark for the student.
