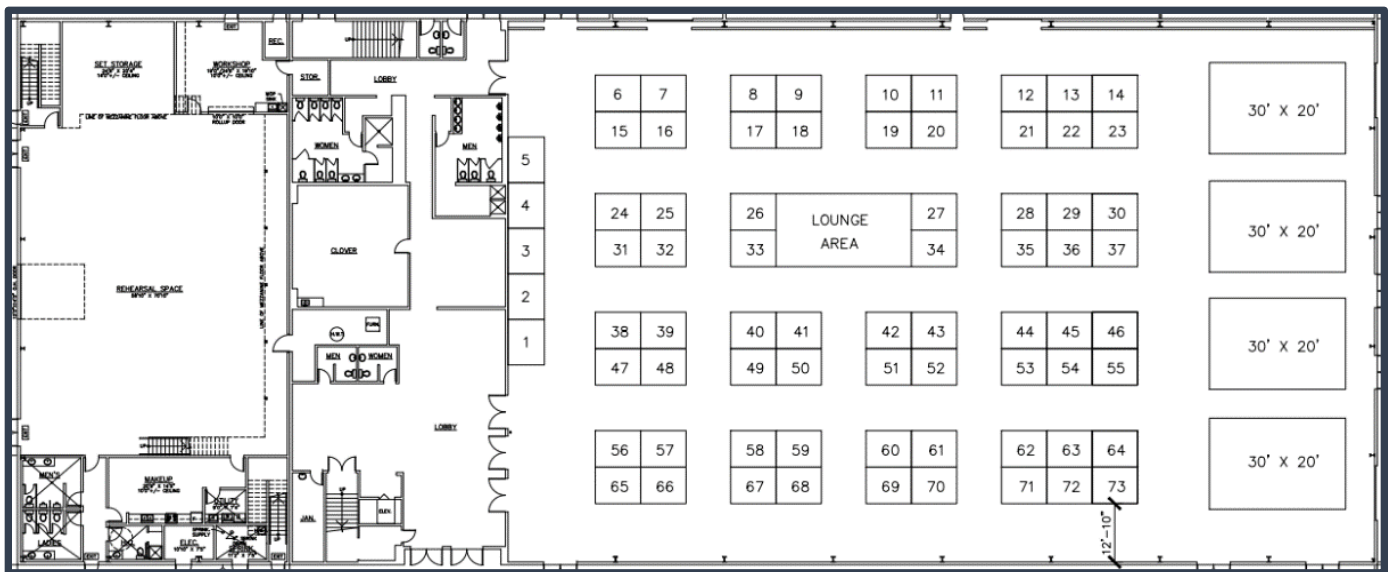


ROTARY CLIMATE FAIR – JOIN US!

The Rotary Club of Chilliwack is thrilled to announce that it will be hosting its first *Rotary Climate Fair* on April 15th and 16th, 2023, at the Landing Sports Centre in Chilliwack, BC.

This fair will be free to the public and will have three main focuses:

1. **Trade show** – Companies will be invited to showcase their programs, technologies, products, and services that enhance people’s lives and save them money, while being low-carbon, and gentle on the environment. Information about grants that support the purchase of some of these products will also be available.



2. **Job fair** – The event will be advertised as a job fair so that companies can accept resumes from people seeking jobs in the new and developing alternative energy and low/no carbon industries.
3. **Speakers** – A program of experts in the field of climate change will be invited to speak at the event. Between speakers, some carefully selected documentaries may also be shown.

REGISTRATION

We are purposely keeping the cost to vendors low, so that all can participate. For-profit companies, who will be displaying products and services, will be asked to pay the fees defined below. Not-for-profit organizations and service groups will have this cost waived.

Do not wait to register! Space is finite and we will be limiting the number of vendors promoting similar products and services. Each vendor will be adjudicated to ensure that their business is consistent with the purpose of the event and will be accepted on a "first come, first serve" basis.
